ITEM	DISCUSSION
Welcome & Introductions	Welcomed Chuck Butler from the Fire Department. He will be a great source for narcan administration numbers.
Evaluation & Feedback from National Recovery Month (Prevention Pillar)	MaryAdele Revoy reported that events for the Month were a great success. Both large community events, Addiction Awareness Day and Recovery Rocks, would like to be an annual event. Committee may want to research the possibility of having one budget to sponsor all the events during the month, instead of multiple contacts to community funders from multiple people. Federal Take-Back Day, 9/26/15, at Recovery Rocks did not collect a great deal of material, but it was great outreach and media awareness. Officer Todd Kronberg had his picture taken with Attorney General Brad Schimel, who noticed the Take-Back Medication Station right away. Officer Kronberg noted that there were approximately 4-5 families that went home to get their medicine when they saw the service.
State Take-Back Day, October 17, 2015 (Harm Reduction Pillar)	Every location will be open from 10:00am-1:00pm. Captain Veaser has organized officers at 5 locations and Officer Kronberg will be at Generations in Plymouth. All materials will be taken to SPD so the MEG Unit can deliver to drop-off location. Generations/Plymouth = Libby Holte and Suzan Thiel Howards Grove = Liz Abler, Patricia Holstein (?) Oostburg = Kim & Henry Meller and MaryAdele Revoy Random Lake = Ellen Wells & her team from Probation & Parole St. Nick's = Green Team MaryAdele will write up suggestions on how to set up the station to send to the volunteers. She will also send the survey volunteers should be using.
