They will be asking superintendents to give out a short survey about where they are at/gaps and the youth risk behavior survey. SASD has an AODA supervisor but it is only one person and it is 10% of his job. Libby and Deb are meeting with the SASD AODA supervisor (Regan). Sue asked them to ask Regan about the good behavior game that Kurt mentioned at a previous meeting.</p> <p>Annette and Jessica are working on updating the presentation PowerPoint. They are also working on a log of where it is being presented. It is not yet ready to be presented to "train the trainer". Discussion took place regarding the best time to have a training on the presentation. There are concerns regarding adding more locations because in the fall we struggled to staff the 5 locations.</p>

He is hoping to recruit more people for the pillar at the networking event, including a possible treatment pillar chair.</p> <p>Discussion took place regarding “Medical detailing” being adopted for prevention purposes.</p>
