Report Out on Action Steps from Previous Meeting	<p>-January 6th Sheboygan Schools Superintendent Meeting: Kari and Shelby. Scott Caldwell from DPI says the screeners should be from the schools. Do we see extra screeners coming on board if the schools feel overwhelmed. Tom M. says it is very important for groups in the community to support the school staff. He was thinking of an on call system of a large number of people. There are concerns with confidentiality and that school staff won't become proficient because it would most often go to the on call back-up. Aurora willing to support programs like Path, but cannot help support the on call SBIRT for the schools.</p> <p>Group discussed if there would be value in going to schools individually to listen to what their barriers are.</p> <p>Next step: 2/15/17 at next meeting. Individuals from schools will be meeting with Scott Caldwell to work through barriers. It will not be a regular SBIRT meeting, but any SBIRT members are welcome to attend.</p> <p>-Acuity money for SBIRT August trainings: Kari</p> <p>Libby mentioned Alliance for Wisconsin Youth. Sometimes they have money they need to spend on local coalitions. She will apply for SBIRT trainings for up to 40 school personnel and then the Acuity money could be used for other things.</p>
