Follow-up on what needs to be discussed before moving forward with SBIRT process. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Where is each organization at in the process, grant update 	<p>Grant update- It was decided that the committee will not apply for the grant in this cycle but will do more planning, look at a target population, system process for SBIRT and areas for referral is needed for most systems. Leslie Patterson from the Wisconsin Medical College is willing to partner with us in the next 6 month cycle of the grant.</p> <p>Kristin announced that she talked to the leadership of both hospital systems and they are willing to implement SBIRT in their systems. Shelby presented to the Aurora Sheboygan Clinic. She stated that there were many questions and how the grant would help with the implementation. Kristin stated that a consistent message needs to be told to all systems.</p>
Moving forward – creating tasks for committee members working towards the completion of activities to move objectives forward.	<p>Cindy will do research and present on how other clinics/ hospital systems have implemented SBIRT and benefits from SBIRT in the community at our 1/20/16 meeting.</p> <p>Discussion of billing for SBIRT and the level of training that is needed for each level of providers. Discussion about the SBIRT training needed and how that could be done in our community. A survey after one year of implementation would need to be done. Kristin stated that the committee needs to decide what clinic types or areas and what population and what tool would be recommended to the providers.</p> <p>Kari Keller stated the Fond du Lac schools have been doing SBIRT for 10 years. She will get more information on that for the committee.</p>
